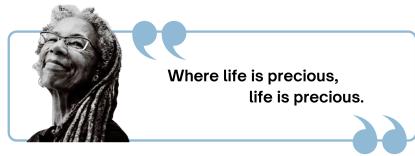

In a highly individualistic country where the government has long since abandoned its people for the sake of making profit, where the mainstream narrative has put the onus onto the individual to make a choice–mask or no mask, you do you–we owe it to each other to keep ourselves and one another safe.

of us have seen our communities shrink, grow tired and get sicker. For marginalized people across the world, each day has been doused in distress by the capitalist elites who are waiting for us to eagerly march into our own coffins.

Sometimes, there are no words left to say. But, we implore all of us to replace silence with screaming, sobbing, the sounds of grief. We deserve to feel devastated. We deserve to stop pedaling on through labyrinths of productivity and distraction. We deserve time to feel the pain we've been conditioned to fear feeling.

Hope requires grief. If we can't mourn what has been taken from us, how can we begin to imagine what we can give to gach other? How can we appreciate mourning when this guief is needless? How do we learn from this mourning when our sorrow is relentless? Mourning in grief requires gentle or sharp release, yet there is no release when our mourning persists. We want grief to be protound and not just a solitary grief, we can connect to others. Grief remembers joy in our relationships and our humanity, and delivers ourselves to the purpose we live. Everyone deserves not only bare minimum relationships and our humanity, and delivers ourselves to the safety, but also joy, depth, and community throughout their lives.

You can make the choice to stop abandoning the communities that you want to have solidarity with. Community is not just a word that liberal institutions

We owe it to the youth, our children, and our children's children, who are already inheriting an earth that is actively being killed by capitalists, and who will bear the brunt of both the pandemic and the ever evolving climate crisis, the consequences of which we cannot yet fully see.

We owe it to our elders, who have lived through the HIV epidemic, and to our disabled loved ones, whose lives are seen as disposable from the eyes of the state and society.

It has been three years since the COVID-19 pandemic began, and in these three years at least 1.1 million people in the so-called "united states" have died from the deadly virus. As per a recent study, an estimated 15 to 20 million people have died worldwide.

Hundreds of millions more have developed long COVID, a debilitating chronic illness, the effects of which we simply do not yet fully understand.

It is not a coincidence that we have not been able to collectively mourn the deaths of millions and the disablement of millions more. It is not a coincidence that the public health emergency ended, and shortly after the CDC made recommendations on improving indoor ventilation systems in schools.

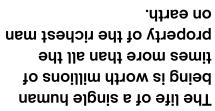

This is the money model of disablement—a concept first articulated by Marta Russell—in action. Russel explains that "... persons who do not offer a body which will enhance profitmaking as laborers are used to shore up US capitalism by other means." This is organized abandonment, a term coined by Ruth Wilson Gilmore, which is "the deliberate manipulation and disproportionate dispossession of resources from Black, Brown, Indigenous, disabled, and poor communities, rendering them more vulnerable to adverse health."

Disabled people, i.e. people "who are deemed to be surplus[,] are rendered excess by the systems of capitalist production and have been consequently framed as a drain or burden on society. But the surplus population has become an essential component of capitalist society, with many industries built on the maintenance, supervision, surveillance, policing, data extraction, confinement, study, cure, measurement, treatment, extermination, housing, transportation, and care of the surplus. In this way, those discarded as non-valuable life are maintained as a source of extraction and profit for capital.

This rather hypocritical stance—the surplus are at once nothing and everything to capitalism—is an essential contradiction. Liat Ben-Moshe identifies this characteristic through the intersection of disability and incarceration: 'Surplus populations are spun into gold. Disability is commodified through [a] matrix of incarceration (prisons, hospitals, nursing homes).' Jasbir Puar, in The Right to Maim: 'Debilitation and the production of disability are in fact biopolitical ends unto themselves... Maiming is a source of value extraction from populations that would otherwise be disposable.'"

# THE TRUTH ABOUT COVID

#1: COVID is airborne and spreads like smoke.

It comes in through your respiratory system, but often spreads to other systems in your body. Most people get COVID by breathing in air that contains tiny aerosols that can linger in the air for hours.

higher death rate than the flu.

#### **#2:** COVID is not like the flu.

Although the seasonal flu spreads globally like COVID-19, the mortality rate for the flu is much lower. Multiple reinfections within a season are unlikely for the flu (once you have natural immunity, you won't be reinfected during the same season), whereas you can be re-infected with SARS-CoV-2 since there are so many different variants in circulation and each variant does not necessarily confer immunity to another.

treatments, Biden refuses to risk reinfection because he fully understands the devastating, and potentially deadly, consequences of COVID-19, yet he repealed nationwide COVID safety measures, indicating that these precious COVID resources should only go to the elite, not the general public.

Make no mistake, the policy choices of the Trump and Biden administration have resulted in an immense number of preventable deaths. Their motives had nothing to do with acience or safety; it was about pushing people back to in-person work to continue consolidating profit in the hands of the ruling class. Workers were forced into extremely dangerous conditions under threat of losing insurance coverage during a pandemic. Rather than encouraging non-pharmaceutical interventions (such as universal masking and better indoor ventilation) to prevent COVID surges, the government instead is allowing pharmaceutical companies to seize on this opportunity to profit off our illness.

For example, Jeff Zients, the previous White House Coronavirus Coordinator and the current Chief of Staff, was delegated the power to invoke the Defense Production Act. Despite this, he let the market dictate the supply and cost of PPE rather than ramping up production and supplying the people with the necessary equipment. This is a pattern that we have seen in the past and we know this is a tool of the medical industrial complex. The continued worship of the free market has left workers bereft of protective measures, subsequently generating many COVID variants. With measures, subsequently generating many COVID variants. With each new variant, the protection of outdated immunization lessens.

The bourgeois government is incentivized to allow mass deaths and disablement because the medical industrial complex—pharmaceutical industry, healthcare conglomerates, insurance companies, etc—is just as capable of extracting profit from our companies, etc—is just as capable of extracting profit from our disabled bodies as industry is from our labor.

## #3: COVID is a vascular disease.

This means that it affects the blood vessels in your body, causing inflammation and damage to the vascular system. This can lead to a range of complications, including blood clots, organ damage, and increased risk of cardiovascular problems. Your vascular system connects all parts of your body, meaning that COVID can harm essentially any system in your body.

## #4: COVID continues to kill.

Since the pandemic began, there have been almost 7 million reported COVID-19 deaths worldwide. This is likely an underestimate, as many COVID deaths have gone unreported and uncounted. ## A CRITIQUE OF CAPITALISM

The current administration has been more preoccupied with managing people's perception of the virus than managing the virus itself, echoing their predecessors whom they claim to have delivered us from. Corporate media, which was quick and accurate in criticizing Trump's mishandling of the pandemic, turned a blind eye as COVID-19 cases and deaths rose under Biden. It aided in manufacturing the narrative that we must learn to "live with the virus," and that mask usage, physical distancing, and other public health measures are only for the risk-averse. Not only is this narrative false, it is eugenics in action.

Both Democrats and Republicans are complicit in this violence, because both are mere puppets monopolized by the ruling class.

At the Detroit Auto Show in September 2022, Biden said, "The pandemic is over. We still have a problem with COVID. We're still doing a lotta work on it. It's-- but the pandemic is over. if you notice, no one's wearing masks. Everybody seems to be in pretty good shape." However, his actions spoke to the contrary. When Biden visited Richard Montgomery High School to give a speech, they installed a state of the art ventilation system in the gym.

During a press briefing that took place on July 18, 2023, Press Secretary Karine Jean-Pierre said, "So, as you know, we have testing protocols . . . anytime somebody meets with the President. So I can tell you that anybody who meets with the President does indeed get tested." Despite having access to the best doctors and

### #5: COVID is a mass disabling event.

Long COVID is a common outcome after a COVID infection, especially repeat infections, and encompasses various persisting symptoms. You might seem to "recover" from the acute infection and then get sick again. There is no guarantee on when or if people with Long COVID will recover.

### #6: Long COVID can affect anyone,

even adults and children without pre-existing conditions —even if vaccinated. The more times you get COVID, the more damage is done and the more at risk you are for serious disease, Long COVID, and death. Long COVID has no cure and is a serious disability affecting millions of people, affecting their quality of life and forcing people out of work.

#### Talk to people about COVID safety.

When talking to someone about COVID safety, be sure to meet them where they are and recognize their humanity. Remember that they, like everyone else, have been bombarded with ruling class propaganda that normalizes eugenics so that they can extract profits off our sick bodies. Lead with your heart, and let science guide your talking points.

#### Consider the following quotes from Mao:

- "Communists must use the democratic method of persuasion and education when working among the laboring people and must on no account resort to commandism or coercion."
- "Our comrades must understand that ideological remolding involves long-term, patient and painstaking work, and they must not attempt to change people's ideology, which has been shaped over decades of life, by giving a few lectures or by holding a few meetings. Persuasion, not compulsion, is the only way to convince them. Compulsion will never result in convincing them. To try to convince them by force simply won't work. This kind of method is permissible in dealing with the enemy, but absolutely impermissible in dealing with comrades or friends."



#### **#8:** Masks make a difference.

The purpose of masking is to keep the concentration of viral particles in the air low. For this reason, one way masking is not as effective as universal masking. If the concentration of viral particles in the air is high, then one runs a higher risk of infection than if the concentration is low. This is precisely why a masked person is unfortunately still at risk of infection - because people around them are not masking so they are taking in more viral particles.

You can protect yourself and the people around you by masking up. Cloth masks have been found to reduce exposure to respiratory viruses by 60 percent, surgical masks by 76 percent and N95 masks by 99 percent. A mask should cover both your nose and mouth, otherwise, it is not effective.

In 2020, people were very accurately criticizing Trump for saying, "If we stop testing right now, we'd have very few cases". So, unsurprisingly, the dismantling of public testing infrastructure under Biden and the shift to at-home rapid testing has resulted in a significant undercounting and underreporting of positive COVID cases and related deaths (including those from Long COVID complications).

While mainstream media has reported on the latest surge (Summer 2023), they aren't typically a reliable source and there have been multiple surges that they haven't reported on. Testing COVID levels in wastewater is now the best remaining measure for assessing COVID risk, and it continues to show high levels of the virus are widespread. Staying informed about wastewater data outside of media coverage is one of the best ways to prepare for surges.

# "COVID IS MILDER NOW"

#### "I'M VAXXED"

Officials claiming that we are completely COVID safe with a vaccine-only strategy displays a total lack of understanding of how the vaccine works and the conditions under which vaccine efficacies were initially determined. The high efficacies pharmaceutical companies were initially claiming were determined when there were several public health measures in place, including masking, limited occupancy, and other restrictions on indoor gatherings. Unrestrained spread of the virus leads to the emergence of new variants, rendering our existing vaccines less effective. Newer COVID strains are just as severe as older variants. Even if a newer strain is considered less deadly, it can be more transmissible which can ultimately lead to more deaths overall.

Vaccines also do not prevent you from getting sick or spreading COVID: they reduce your chances of ending up dead or in the hospital. We must continue to employ other methods of protection to keep ourselves and our communities safe. The newer COVID strains may appear to be milder because fewer people are dying compared to the start of the pandemic, but this can be attributed to the sheer number of people with comorbidities that lost their lives during the early COVID waves. Fewer people are dying presently because so many of our most at-risk members of society have already died from COVID. Our government has subsequently abandoned remaining at-risk individuals, who have been forced to take their safety into their own hands as the world prematurely "moves on" from the ongoing pandemic.

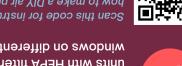

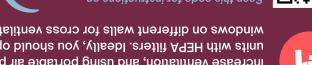


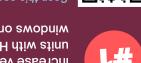

Participants with evidence of organ impairment from blood or MRI assessment received another multi-organ MRI body scan six months later. The scans revealed a small decline in patients experiencing organ impairment in at least two organs, from 29% to 27% (97 and 88 out of 331, respectively). The study also revealed an improvement in their long COVID symptoms between 6 and 12 months – severe breathlessness dropped from 36% to 28% of patients, cognitive dysfunction from 48% to 38%, and poor health-related quality of life from 55% to 42%.

Long COVID

While the consequences of long COVID remain to be fully uncovered, one thing is clear: it is imperative to take all the precautions necessary to prevent SARS-CoV-2 infections and reinfections.

Using the US Veterans Health Administration (VHA) health database, researchers compared more than 150,000 US veterans who survived the first 30 days of COVID-19

and two uninfected control groups – from a group of over 5 million people who have used the VHA medical system during the pandemic and a similarly sized group that used the system before the pandemic in 2017. They then estimated the risk of a set of 20 different cardiovascular outcomes one-year post-acute infection. The study found that relative to the uninfected control groups, people who had recovered from COVID-19 exhibited increased risk for multiple cardiovascular problems one year after infection.

The increased risk of death, hospitalization and all other health outcomes was observed regardless of vaccination status. The study also showed that risks increased with every infection. In other words: 2 infections is worse than 1, 3 infections is worse than 2, and so on.

Most recently, an observational study conducted in the UK and published in February 2023, found that as many as 6 in 10 people with long COVID had organ impairment in at least one organ six months out from their initial COVID diagnosis. Importantly, only 13% of patients had symptoms severe enough to require hospitalization at the time of active SARS-CoV-2 infection – meaning most patients had 'mild COVID' at the time of infection.

## Another study published in Nov 2022, examined the health risks of repeat SARS-CoV-2 infections.

Researchers first identified nearly 520,000 VHA users with at least one positive SARS-CoV-2 test between March 1, 2020, and April 6, 2022. Of these

participants, 40,947 were reinfected between June 1, 2020, and June 25, 2022. The one infection and reinfection groups were compared to a noninfected control group of more than 5.3 million people who did not test positive for SARS-CoV-2 infection.

Researchers found, compared to people with no reinfection, those who are infected with SARS-CoV-2 two or more times are:
